WORKING TOGETHER ANNUAL REPORT-2010-2011

Noidaities are aware of the immense difference that NOIDA LOK MANCH, a registered non-profit, non-political socially conscious NGO since 1998 is meant for the lives of the people of Gautam Budh Nagar. Working single-mindedly and purposefully towards its goals since its inception, NOIDA LOK MANCH has proved its unchallenged ability to identify its projects and achieve its targets through its community development programmes making it a **People's Movement-of the people, for the people by the people.** In these last 12 years it has established its credibility and become a familiar name in most households. Enumerated below are some of the activities in which the Noida Lok Manch was engaged during this year.

1. Due to increase in the number of students in the Library, a second reading room was opened for the students on 20.04.2010.
2. An amount of Rs.5000/- were donated to our Safai staff member for gall bladder operation of her husband and an amount of Rs.1500/- were donated for treatment of Kumari Nandani d/o Shri Rajender from Sector 8 jhuggis.
3. With the help of M/S Divine India Infrastructure P Ltd, Noida Lok manch helped handicapped Shri Harendra Kumar of Khora Colony by providing him with a Tricycle.
4. On 25th June 2010, Narain Bhojan Sewa was started at Antim Niwas. Free lunch from 12.00 pm to 1.30pm is being provided to approximately 100 people everyday.
5. To help another handicapped girl, Vandana Yadav from Chitrakoot, a donation of Rs. 25000/- towards her admission fee into BEd. at JRH

University was made. This amount was contributed by three of our esteemed volunteers Shri Anand Chauhan & Shri Yadav Singh and Prakash Hospital Noida .Staff members collected some stationery items and clothes which were also handed over to her.

6. In July 2010, the Noida Authority laid the foundation stone for construction of CNG facility at Antim Niwas cremation ground. The
7. construction work is in progress.
8. On 10th and 11th August 2010, 40 students of Ajay Kumar Garg Institute of Management from Ghaziabad along with two of their faculty members visited our Library, and the three Sanskar Kendra Schools. A project on NLM and options of funding was prepared by them and on 14th August. Shri Mahesh Saksena, Shri Ashok Tewari, Shri R P Upadhyaya and Smt. Vibha Bansal visited the Institute for the presentation by the students.
9. Steria India donated and got installed 9 new computers at the Computer Center at Library.
10. On 25th Sept and 26th Sept an Art Exhibition was organized at the Library. Paintings by Lt Col Karam Jit Singh and his students were exhibited. Many dignitaries visited the same.
11. NIIT-Institute of Information Tecnology (TNT) opened their second center with Noida Lok Manch at the Library premises in Sept 2010. This Centre would be providing vocational training to the underprivileged youth residing in villages/slums. After training they would be provided employment opportunities to those students who qualify and get the CLC Certificate.
12. Noida Lok Manch donated 3 sewing machines to a vocational training school at Village Ajayabpur which is being run by Sh. Satender Bhatti.
13. Lions Club of Noida distributed dengue medicine to the villagers and school students of Sanskar Kendra School in village Sector 68 & Sector 115.
14. A free homeopathic clinic has been started at Noida Public Library premises under the guidance of Dr N P Singh from 5th October 2010. There is no consultation fee and medicine for one week is given at a

- nominal charge of Rs.5/-. A total of 500 patients have availed this facility till 31st March 2011.
15. Mrs. Rashmi Gupta and Mrs. Vibha Bansal donated Rs. 1000/- for handicapped girl from Chitrakoot Vandana Yadav.

 16. In the month of October 2010, Lions Club and Noida Lok Manch helped another handicapped boy Shri Shishu Pal by giving him a tricycle for his use.
 17. In October only Noida Lok Manch donated two wheeled stretchers to the Government Hospital at Sector 39.
 18. In December 2010, sweaters and socks were distributed by the Agarwal Mitra Mandal at Sanskar Kendra School Village Garhi Sector 68.
 19. In January 2011, bedding material, kitchen utensils, ration sewing machine, colour TV Videocon, one Almirah, sarees and make up kit were collected for marriage of poor girl in Hoshairpur village.
 20. In the month of Jan 2011, Shri Anand Chauhan ji distributed 50 blankets for the Leprosy patients at the Govt Hospital Sector 39.
 20. The Sanskar Kendra Schools celebrated their Annual Day on 8th Feb 2011 with great pomp and show. The function was held at the Sector 68 Garhi Chaukhandi school from 11am to 2 pm. Smt Rewa Nayyar of Essel Foundation was the Chief Guest. Other distinguished guests were Shri Ritesh Kumar, Shri Anurag Gupta and Smt. Bimla Bajoria. The school children put up an impressive craft exhibition as well as dance and drama programmes. Parents of the children also attended the function.
 21. The Noida Lok Manch was once again entrusted by the Noida Authority to provide Mids Day Meals to the indoor patients at the Government hospital at Sector 39. This facility was started on 11th Feb 2011. The afternoon meal is being provided by Sai Mandir Sector 62 and the evening meal is being provided by Noida Lok Manch.
