WORKING TOGETHER ANNUAL REPORT-2011-2012

Noidaities are aware of the immense difference that NOIDA LOK MANCH, a registered non-profit, non-political socially conscious NGO since 1998 is meant for the lives of the people of Gautam Budh Nagar. We continued as an established leader in the district as a people's initiative, making educational and medical services and facilities available and accessible to the weakest segments of society without any discrimination. . Enumerated below are some of the activities in which the Noida Lok Manch was engaged during this year.

The Library was chosen as the venue by many management students who had the need to prepare projects and news bulletins for their course projects. Students from Moscow Media Sector 58 Noida, Amity Business School, and various other colleges of Greater Noida visited the Library throughout the year. Books made available by Dr Atul Bhatnagar of Subharti University Meerut, were distributed to many students.

Four girls (belonging to the weaker section & handicapped) marriages were solemnized by the help of Noida Lok Manch. Sarees, shawls, beddings, utensils, silver items, food items, blanket and cash amount of Rs.64100/- were given for the four marriages.

Government of Uttar Pradesh undertook the project of construction of the Goernemtn Hospital at Sector 30 and the patients were shifted to temporary hospital at Sector 39. Keeping in view Noida Lok Manch's track record of being available for the benefit of the needy, Noida Authority requested our NGO to provide the meals to the indoor patients. We have been providing

the evening meals to the patients at Sector 39 and now since the hospital has been shifted back to Sector 30 , we are still providing evening meals to nearly 130 indoor patients 365 days a year.

We have also been providing meals to the 35-40 children at the Madarassa at Sector 16 Jhuggis. Ration like 200kg Atta, 95kg rice, 27kg dal salt and aachar have been provided to them. Every week we try to provide these children with a glass of milk, rusks and fruit.

Peanuts, rewari & ladoos were distributed to the students at the Primary & Junior schools at Naya Bans, Sector 17 Jhuggi children and at the Sector 16 madarasaa on the occasion of Makar Sankriti. 150 shawls and 100 sarees were distributed among the people at Sector 16 & 17 Jhuggis through their respective Pradhans. Four tables and four chairs were donated for use at the Primary School Naya Bans.

The free meal afternoon distribution programme of Narain Bhojan Sewa started in Antim Niwas since June 2010 is still catering to the need of nearly 70-80 people everyday.

A long cherished goal of Noida Lok Manch was to start an ITI for the students and this project materialized on 5th October 2011 when the Center was inaugurated at Sanskar Kendra School Village Garhi Chaukhandi Sector 68. A hawan puja was held and construction of the building was completed by November 2011. The electrical and computer classes started on 1st November 2011. At present the number of students is not much but it is picking up slowly.

The three Sanskar Kendra Schools have been doing remarkable work in the field of education. Their strength is increasing day by day and quality of education, the sanskars being imparted and all round development with the help of co curricular activities has brought out immense talent from amongst the students.

The Annual Day Function of the three schools was held with great pomp and show on 24th March 2012 at 11 am at Hoshiarpur School. The Chief Guest of the function was Mrs Vimla Bajoria and many distinguished guests such as Dr Mahesh Sharma, Sh anand Chauhan, Dr narendra Gupta, Sh N P Singh

Col S K Sabhlok, Smt Rajni Kaul and others attended the programme.
Lovely dance programmes and drama were presented

In support of the Anti Corruption Movement of Anna Hazareji, a rally was organized from Ram Lila Ground Sector 21 Noida to Shaeed Samarak Samiti at Sector 29 on 24th August 2011. A large number of Noidaites, social activists of Noida, students, housewives etc participated in the rally wish was a huge success.

At the Antim Niwas large scale upgradation continued throughout the year. Boundary walls were constructed, a new CNG plant has been installed in a newly constructed building. The supply of CNG has yet to be started. A new Office complex is under construction. The Narain Bhojan Sewa started last year is continuing and approximately 100 people avail the facility every day. On the occasion of Maha Shiv Ratri, the Shiv Pariwar was installed at Antim Niwas under the canopy of the Krishan Arjun Rath.
