



# Annual Report 2014-2015

Another year has been added to our wonderful journey of social commitment.

Noidaities are aware of the immense difference that NOIDA LOK MANCH, a registered non-profit, non-political socially conscious NGO since 1998 is meant for the lives of the people of GautamBudh Nagar. We continued as an established leader in the district as a people's initiative, making educational and medical services and facilities available and accessible to the weakest segments of society without any discrimination.

Enumerated below are some of the activities in which the Noida Lok Manch was engaged during this year.

## 1. Community Radio Station

One of our new social projects this year was the launch of our Community Radio Station which has been granted to us **by the Ministry of Information & Broadcasting ( frequency 91.2MHz) . Our radio station is the 4<sup>th</sup> in District Gautam Budh Nagar and 1<sup>st</sup> in Greater Noida area. The Community Radio station has been set up at Village Tilipta, Greater Noida as a social step towards upliftment of village folks with a view to strengthen and motivate their cultural & heritage qualities. This will provide us a perfect opportunity to utilize this media to directly interact with the community with the help of community itself. The community talent along with our dedicated team can help to enlighten the community about its rights and duties, highlighting social issues and empowerment of youth women & senior citizens which will uplift the society country and the community at large.**

Since its launch in August 2014, the radio station is gaining popularity. Local artists, school children Ragni artists have recorded numerous programmes and they are being regularly aired. At present we are airing two hour programmes in three shifts i.e. morning afternoon and evening. The project of Community Radio is under the Chairmanship of Shri Yogendra Narain IAS, Ex Defense Secretary and Ex General Secretary Rajya Sabha along with a team of experts working under his guidance and patronage.

## **2. Village Development**

The Noida Lok Manch management has decided to adopt two villages of District Gautam Budh Nagar for their holistic development. In this process the first village identified by our NGO is Village Shahapur Sector 128, Noida and the other one shall be in Greater Noida/Yamuna Expressway after consultation and proper guidance from District Administration.

In this development process of Village Shahapur, the inaugural projects are health and computer literacy. On 21<sup>st</sup> March Saturday at Village Shahpur , a health camp of cancer awareness and detection, courtesy of Dharamshila Cancer Hospital and a general health check up camp under the supervision of our expert medical team from Government Hospital Sector 30 Noida was organized . Computer Literacy Project was also launched on this day.

Gradually we will take up other necessary programmes in the developmental process ie toilet facilities, Library, sanskar schools, computer literacy centre , regular games and sports competitions for youth as well as measures to prevent malnutrition in the area through our volunteers and other mass awareness campaigns.

## **3. Education**

**Three Sanskar Kendra Schools** are being managed by **Noida Lok Manch**. The Schools are being run for the multi – faceted development and welfare of children from villages and backward areas. Many individuals from the higher strata of society like retired IAS Officers, Senior Teachers, Principals and Women volunteers from good families are helping and cooperating in running these schools.

SanskarKendra Schools, from Nursery till class V111, are situated in village Sharfabad, Sec 73, village GarhiChaukhandi Sec 68, village Sorakha, Sec 115 and are **recognized by NIOS**. The school timings are 8.45am to 2.15pm.

### **Regular Inter School Competitions and Inter Village School Competitions**

were held during the year. Some of the competitions encouraged were rangoli making, poster making, drawing, sports as well as Hindi & English word competitions. **Regular Participation at the BalSahyog NGO**

**interaction meets.** This enables our School children to interact with the Committee at large and to feel how much the society is concerned in their better upbringing.

Sanju Mahoto of Class V stood 1<sup>st</sup>, Aarti Khuswaha of Class IV stood 2<sup>nd</sup> and Laxmi Diwakar Class V stood 3<sup>rd</sup>. Arya Pathak of Class IV received the consolation prize of Rs 500/- . All these students were from Sanskar Kendra Schools.

Max India Foundation ,Delhi organized vaccination camps in the months of Sept/Oct/and Nov 2014. Vaccinations for Typhoid, Hepatitis B and MMR were administered to all the students. A health check up camp was organized by Doctors from the District Govt Hospital Sector 30 on 17.01.2015 at Sanskar Kendra School Sarfabad for all students and villagers.

The Annual Day was held on 14.02.2015 at Village Sarfabad. Chief Guest- Smt. Reva Nayyar, Retd IAS (Sec GOI), Shri Prabhat Kumar , Retd IAS (Cabinet Sec GOI), President of NLM , Shri P K Mishra , Retd IAS (

Former Principal Sec and Member UPSC), CEO of NLM, Shri Mahesh Saxena, Gen Sec NLM and Smt. Vidya Devi, landlady of the school premises lighted the lamp. The cultural programmes (dance/drama/songs & yoga) presented by the students of the three schools were applauded with great cheer by the gathering. Smt Reva Nayyar and Shri Prabhat Kumar were highly impressed and appreciated the hard work done by the teachers and students.

**With would like to bring to your notice that in the year 2011- 20 children, 2012- 20 , 2013- 24 , 2014- 12, and 2015- 16 students of class VIII passed out and got admission into different Government schools of Noida. In the year 2012, Ikcha a previous student of SKS scored 86% in Class X CBSC Board. In the year 2014 , Yoga Nand(a previous student) scored 96.6% in Class X from CBSC Board.**

Renovation work on the ground floor , construction of new toilets, construction of dome etc are in the pipeline and work is going on. The Noida Authority has been kind enough to provide some new glass almirahs and other furniture is also expected soon.

## **5. AntimNiwas**

**The AntimNiwas management was handed over to us by NOIDA AUTHORITY in 2001.** During these 14 years with the help and guidance of our volunteers and Donors as well as the Noida Authority, we have been

able to offer not only sympathy but assistance and empathy to make the final parting easier on those who have the onerous duty of performing the last rites for the departed soul.

**This is the only Shavdahgrah in India with fixed costs and charges without any variable or discriminatory/premium rates of facilities. Absolute free cremation services are provided for any unclaimed body and the economically weaker section is given discount depending on the financial capacity of the family of the deceased.**

## **6. Disaster Management**

You are aware that since 1997, Noida Lok Manch has always been at the fore front of providing help to the victims of the natural calamities that strikes the country be it at Nagapatnam, Bhuj, Bihar , Orissa or Uttrakhand. We could take this responsibility to some extent if not to the larger magnitude just because of the trust, support and sensitiveness for such causes by the Corporates, Industries and Trusts that are our support line and such prompt support under their CSR responsibility, certainly encourages and motivates us to dream big.

In September 2014, the state of Jammu & Kashmir experienced devastating floods and landslides in the country's worst natural disaster. Numerous people tourists and locals lost their lives.

Two consignments of relief material were sent to the deluge affected people of Kashmir. A team of six Doctors reached Kashmir on 21<sup>st</sup> Sept to start a free health check up camp at Batmaloo near Kashmir High Court . In this team two residents of Kashmir Dr. Sarvat Sameena and Dr Saulat Saba who had been already working at Noida Satya Hospital along with paramedical team , set up a 24 day camp. This team along with necessary medicines , food items, tents, blankets, sanitary napkins and biscuits etc worth approximately Rs. 5 lacs reached through flight to Batmaloo and started the camp.

## **8. Health Causes**

Organizing of regular health camps has been another feather in the Noida Lok Manch's journey of serving the needy. The Noida Public Library 's Readers were in the forefront to carry out Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's campaign of Swatch Bharat Abhiyan when they took upon themselves to clean their Library Sector and its surrounding.

Three free Cancer Awareness and Detection camps along with general health check up camps were organized under the guidance of Dr Y K Kulshreshtha and Dharamshila Cancer Hospital . These camps were organized at Blue Diamond Public School at Sodapur ki Jhall, Dadri, Shri Sant Vinobha Inter College, Baithpura , Greater Noida and at Chauppal, Village Shahapur Sector 128 Noida.

Health camps were also organized in the three Sanskar Kendra Schools by the Government Hospital, Sector 30 Noida and by Max India Foundation ,Delhi. They organized vaccination camps for Typhoid, Hepatitis B and MMR for all the students.
